# 6. SPECIAL EDUCATION AND STUDENT SERVICES

- a. Read Well Presentation and Information
  - i. Andria Buchman, Director of Special Education and Student Services presented on Read Well a reading intervention program selected for special education and student services. Ms. Buchman noted that this comprehensive program was selected to focus on areas that we felt are best suited for our students. Five programs in total were evaluated before selecting Read Well. She then noted that this intervention program has flexible starting points with whole and small group instruction. Implementation will be at the K-3 level. Grant funding will be used to launch this program. Questions were addressed by the Board regarding what was done in the past, consistency of programming and how the training for teachers will be handled. Ms Buchman noted that a training date will be set up and scheduled. This will be done over a day and a half over the summer for teachers. Michael Mahon wrapped up the presentation noting this is the type of comprehensive program outlook we want to move forward with and that with the implementation of teacher training on how to best utilize this will allow them to be successful. A vote on Read Well will be taken in August by the Board.
