Remote Support for Student Technology Issues

 → The Southern Lehigh School District Information Technology Department is able to provide students submitting SLSD Technology Helpdesk Tickets with Remote Support.
→ This cuts the response time to SLSD Technology Helpdesk Tickets Down and ensures that students miss less instruction than they would have without this capability.

Support for Students with Individualized Education Plans

- The Southern Lehigh School District Special Education Department has worked closely with families to develop supports for students to ensure access to services outlined within the Individualized Education Plans which include;
