- **Recess reminder:** <u>Please ensure that your child is dressed appropriately for</u> <u>winter weather.</u> Recess occurs daily throughout the winter, weather permitting.
 - Attendance: The PA school Code, 24 P.S. 13-1326, has identified that students may be absent from school for the following lawful reasons: illness, family emergency, death of a family member, medical appointments, authorized

school activities and pre-approved education travel. The statute identifies 10 cumulative absences as allowable during one school year. Families who go beyond 10 cumulative days of absence for any reason will be required to provide proof of attendance at a medical or judicial agency appointment per the Pennsylvania School Code. The office must receive excuse slips validating the excuse within **three days** of the child returning to school.

• Arriving to school late: Please be advised that arriving to school late is not a good way for your child to start their day. An occasional late start due to a Dr. apt is always excused but children who chronically arrive after our 9AM start time are forced to start their day in a catch-up mode. This is detrimental to their education and a disruption to their educational environment. It also violates compulsory attendance laws.

Let's hope the weather cooperates with us this winter and that we have our snow days on weekends! Please note whenever the district closes, or opts for a late start or early dismissal the superintendent's decision is based upon numerous conversations with our transportation department. Student safety is always the determining factor.
