The SLSD Parent University Series is an online seminar where district staff and/or community partners provide resources to parents and guardians in an effort to support the development of a more advanced understanding of various programs that exist within the Southern Lehigh School District or educate our community on a variety of issues that we are facing.

On September 30th, the SLSD will host the first Parent University Program for the 2021-2022 School Year. This program will feature information about the related resources available within the Southern Lehigh School District School Counseling Department.
