Liberty Trails Summer Camp offers kids something new each day! The adventure begins at Liberty Bell Elementary School where participants will learn background information about the day's experience. Then it's off to the buses! Previously, students have visited Adventure Aquarium, Ashland Coal Mine, Sandy Hook National Recreation Area, Hawk Mountain, Lancaster County, Crystal Cave, Jacobsburg State Park, Tannersville Bog, and more. Included in the L3-day camp is a 2-night cabin camping experience at Pocono Environmental Education Center. Historical, geographical, environmental, and cultural themes are woven into this program.
