

Halloween Parade

Friday, 10/29: AM K at 10:45am; PM K, 1st, 2nd, 3rd at 2:00 pm

- Costumes--Students will need to bring their costumes in a bag labeled with their names. Students will have an opportunity to change into costumes before the parade. Please make sure students can dress themselves in their costumes. All costumes should be school-appropriate. No weapons!
- Parade--The parade will begin at 2:00 pm. We are stretching the route a little bit longer. Students will exit from the side door by the playground, circle the bus loop, and enter back through the front doors of the building. Students will do 2 laps. Parents should stand on any grassy area around the front of the building, side recess yard, or ,in the bus circle area to watch. Please do not stand on the sidewalks.
