- 2. I am available for a phone conference if you or your child would prefer to speak over the phone. Please email me a day and time that works for you, along with the best number to reach you at.
- 3. If you would like to schedule a videoconference with me, I am able to set up a time with you or your child through Zoom. I can arrange this with you or your child on weekdays between 9am 4pm. You have the option of a video and/or audio feature. Therefore, if you are not comfortable with the video aspect, you have the availability to turn that off and just talk through audio.

To Schedule a videoconference with me, please follow these steps:

- 1. Email me your interest with a date and/or possible times you or your child would be available. If possible, these times should be on a weekday between 9am and 4pm. If those days and times do not work for you, we may be able to set up an evening or weekend meeting.
- 2. I will respond to your email with a date, time and a link for you to click on for us to have our conference.
- 3. When that date/time arrives, click on that link and it will take you directly to the videoconference. Before entering the conference, you will have the chance to turn off/on your audio and video capabilities.
