On January 25th, you are invited to attend the SLHS FAFSA Completion Night to receive assistance from PHEAA (Pennsylvania Higher Education Assistance Agency) to complete the FAFSA application. Using this [link](#), you can sign up for a 30 minute time slot (it is recommended that the student attend as well).

- Students need to **create their FSA ID at least 4 days in advance of the workshop**. Any contributor of information to the FAFSA such as a parent(s) also need to create an FSA ID **at least 4 days in advance of the workshop**.
  - You can go to [studentaid.gov/fsa-id](https://studentaid.gov/fsa-id) to create an FSA ID. [Parent\(s\) that have an FSA ID that they previously used, should log into studentaid.gov/fsa-id](#) as they may need to update their password.
- At the workshop, **you and your student will need to have access to text messages and personal email accounts**. When you log in to the Federal Student Aid (FSA) ID to log in to the online FAFSA, it will require a two-step verification process. Each time an FSA ID is used to log in, a one-time code is delivered via email, text message, or an authenticator app.
