	124. SUMMER SCHOOL
1. Authority SC 502, 1901, 1906	It is the policy of the Board that the district may offer a summer program of remedial and enrichment instruction for resident students of this district. This policy is not intended to limit joint activities created when Southern Lehigh and another District cooperate to provide activities for their students collectively.
	In order to support a program of summer instruction, the Board shall:
	1. Employ teaching and administrative staff or contract with providers and proctors including cyberschools.
	2. Purchase or provide necessary books, materials, supplies, and equipment.
	3. Utilize schools or other facilities as required.
	4. Provide necessary custodial services.
Title 22 Sec. 4.41	Courses offered in summer school may be designed as credit or noncredit offerings.
2. Guidelines	Tuition fees established by the Board shall be charged to all participating students.
3. Delegation of Responsibility	The Superintendent or designee shall be responsible for the summer school program.
Responsionity	Regulations for the operation of summer school shall be consistent with Board policies, and the operation of summer school shall not conflict in any way with the administration of the regular school sessions of this district.
