	207. CONFIDENTIAL COMMUNICATIONS OF STUDENTS
1. Purpose	The Board recognizes that some written and oral communications between students and school personnel are confidential.
2. Authority	The Board directs school personnel to comply with all federal and State laws, State Board regulations and Board policy concerning confidential communications of students.
3. Guidelines Title 22 Sec. 12.12	Information received in confidence from a student may be revealed by the staff member who received the information when the health, welfare or safety of the student or other persons clearly is in jeopardy.
Title 22 Sec. 12.12 42 PS Sec. 5945, 8337	Use of a student's confidential communications to school personnel in legal proceedings is governed by statutes and regulations appropriate to the proceedings and as complies with FERPA (Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act).
4. Delegation of Responsibility	In qualifying circumstances, a staff member may reveal confidential information to the building principal and other appropriate authorities.
	In qualifying circumstances, the designee may reveal confidential information to a student's parent or legal guardian and other appropriate authorities, including law enforcement personnel.
