At Liberty Bell School, we are all responsible for our own learning and behavior.

Two incentive programs that exemplify our attitude include the Liberty Bell Lions Club and the Sneaker Chart.

Liberty Bell Lions

The students can earn a "lion" for their class each time their class displays positive behavior during special classes, such as gym, music, art, computer, or library. Each week, a school announcement is made to report the school-wide results. The students work hard to ensure that their class makes the Lion's Club each week. After five weeks, classes who have made the Lion's Club each week earn a certificate to display proudly in the classroom.



Go For a Sneaker

Sneaker Chart

The students can earn a "sneaker" for their class if they are observed to be walking in a nice, quiet line. When another teacher observes the good behavior, he or she will tell the class that they have earned a sneaker. The class will then put a sneaker of a particular color on their chart. Each time the chart is filled with one color the teacher may decide to reward the class with a special prize. The sneaker chart is filled according to the colors of the rainbow: first red ones, then orange, yellow, green, blue, indigo, and blue. The sneaker charts are proudly displayed outside of each classroom.
