Math will start next week. Look for Homework to come home!!!

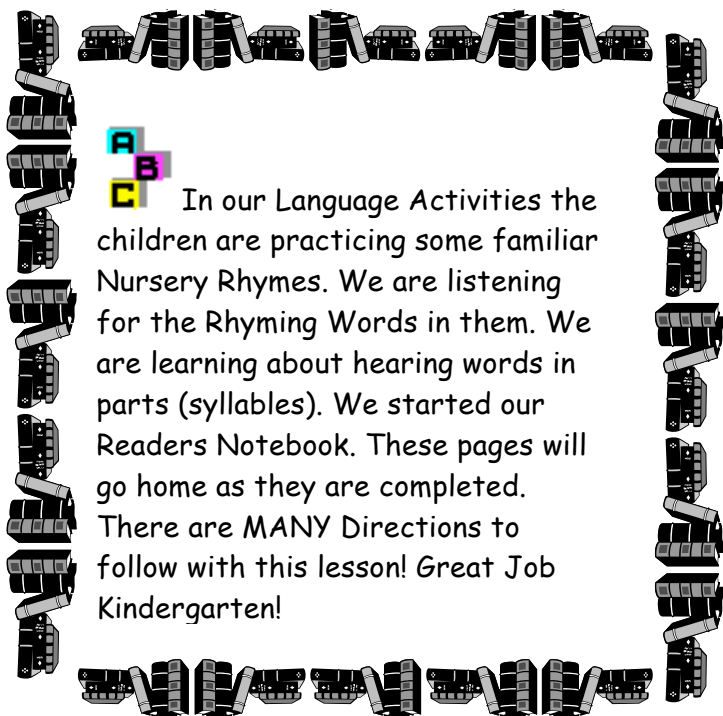


King and Queen
